

Queens-based since 1996, The Youth Orchestra, CYCNY has been a 501 (c) (3) organization since 2002. Our mission is to provide orchestra training and performing opportunities for musical students aged 10 to 18, with a unique repertory that includes Classical, Popular, Jazz, Broadway, Film, and Asian music. The orchestra commissions and premieres works by American and Asian composers and has organized eleven summer concert tours to Asia, Europe, and the West Coast for global and cultural experiences.

New members are recruited through auditions in September and January. Weekly rehearsals take place at Middle School 158 in Bayside, New York from September to June. Our members perform concerts from local community centers to renowned concert venues, such as Alice Tully Hall at Lincoln Center.

The faculty directors are: Patsy Fang Chen, Artistic Director; Chunsheng Jason Chang, Executive Director; Chijen Christopher Chung, Music Director/Conductor; our instructors are: Chijen Christopher Chung and Tony Tungying Huang (Strings), Lovell Park Chang and Hsinhui Karen Liao (Woodwind and Brass), ChiChing Grace Lin (Percussion), Chiwei Chang, (Piano), Liling Hung (Chamber Music), and Hsinyi Samantha Huang are the Librarian.

For the 2020-21 Season, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the orchestra conducted its weekly education program and performed concerts virtually online. Award-winning musician/engineer Yasuhiko Fukuoka edited the spectacular digital submissions from our members, then the Holiday Concert and Annual Concert were presented on YouTube.

Starting the 2021-22 Season, we were back in person, and performed the 24th Holiday Concert on December 19, 2021, and the 19th Annual Concert at Lincoln Center on June 18, 2022.

For the 2022-23 Season, the 25th Holiday Concert will be on December 18, 2022, at the MS 158 in Bayside, and the 20th Annual Concert at Lincoln Center is scheduled to be on June 17, 2023.

紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團

自1998年以來,紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團所推出的《聖誕音樂會Holiday Concert》成為皇后區聖誕佳節傳統慶典之一; 2002年起,每年於林肯中心舉行《年度音樂會Annual Concert》。

紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團秉持著「服務社區‧教育英才」和「幼吾幼以及人之幼」的理念,在社區中多次親善演出,行跡遍及圖書館、公園、學校、社區之耆老,醫療與復健中心等。除每年定期於皇后區舉辦聖誕音樂會與林肯中心年度音樂會之外,曾舉辦九次美亞巡迴(1997、1999、2002、2005、2007、2010、2012、2015、2018)、兩次美國西岸(1998、2000)以及歐洲(2006)演奏之旅,於舊金山、洛杉磯、聖地牙哥、夏威夷、台北、宜蘭、台中、鹿港、高雄、金門、廈門、北京、上海、香港、大阪、東京、橫濱、維也納、薩爾斯堡、布拉格等地,舉辦過數十場親善交流音樂會,不僅開拓了團員們的視野,也達到音樂交流的使命。

2015年7月,紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團和台灣新北市大豐國小校友管弦樂團共赴東京音樂大學以及台北市福華國際文教中心與當地音樂學生親善交流和共同演奏音樂;2018年夏天與桃園六和國中管弦樂團、台中安和國中管樂團及澳門聖公會中學樂團於台中交流,並赴日本橫濱Minato Mirai Hall載譽演出並兼就地旅遊。

紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團招收團員年齡自10歲至18歲,來自預約甄試,經錄取後,每年九月至次年六月之每週六下午一時至四時,假皇后區貝賽158初中(Marie Curie Middle School)排練;由資優老師林季靜、張若葳、張紀葳、黃東瀛、廖信惠、洪莉玲等指導,鍾啟仁擔任音樂總監及指揮。2019-20年度的紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團年度大型聖誕音樂會(2019年12月15日)於貝賽Cardozo高中盛大舉行。

紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團演出的曲目包括古典、流行、爵士、百老匯、電影及亞洲音樂,更開創《幼獅師生才藝表演音樂會》,由本團師生演出獨奏和重奏之室內樂。

自2020年3月15日起,因冠狀病毒COVID-19蔓延,除暫時停止樂團排練外,並取消預定演出之音樂會。

2020-21年度,樂團改以視訊進行預演和排練,面對新時期新挑戰,老師、團員和家長們都認真配合。2020年12月20日 聖誕音樂會及2021年6月12日春季年度音樂會如期上網舉行,特請名音樂家福岡保彥(Yasuhiko Fukuoka)協助音樂編輯。

2021-22年度,樂團恢復正規排練,於12月19日演出其第24年度聖誕音樂會饗宴皇后社區,6月4日法拉盛第7屆音樂會,以及2022年6月18日假林肯中心舉行第19年度公演。

2022-23年度,12月18日舉行第25屆聖誕音樂會;3月25日師生才藝表演音樂會;6月3日法拉盛第8屆音樂會,以及6月17日表演第20屆林肯中心音樂會。

紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團成立於1996年,自1997年向紐約州政府註冊為非營利機構,1998至2007年列入紐約市政府燈塔計劃(The Beacon Program)。1999年起至今多次獲得紐約市皇后藝術基金協會(Queens Council on the Arts)、紐約州藝術基金協會(New York State Council on the Arts)、紐約市文化事務局(New York City Department of Cultural Affairs)、紐約市議會、前市議員顧雅明和市議員黃敏儀及紐約第一銀行等頒發獎助基金;並獲綠洲基金會、The Jatain Foundation、中華民國僑務委員會、駐紐約台北經濟文化辦事處、以及紐約華僑文教服務中心、PatsyChen.com、台灣會館、佳美旅遊、林口印刷、普利斯商務網路等贊助。



A native of Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Mr. Chung began his musical studies in piano, violin and cello at the ages of five and nine. Following a successful musical career in high school, he attended the National Taiwan Normal University where he majored in cello, minored in piano and was awarded the Certificate of Music Education.

Upon moving to the United States, Mr. Chung studied under the tutelage of cellist Peter Wiley (of Guarneri String Quartet), at Conservatory of Music at Purchase College, SUNY, where he received both his Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in Music Performance.

Mr. Chung's wide professional experience encompasses symphony orchestra and chamber music performances, conducting, teaching, studio recording and administration. He served as Associate Principal Cellist of the Taipei Symphony Orchestra, Principal Cellist of the Yin-Qi Symphony Orchestra & Chorus, and the Yin-Qi Chamber Orchestra in Taiwan. He performed with the Chinese Community



Chamber Orchestra at Carnegie Hall, New York Symphony Orchestra and the Amadeus String Quartet and Piano Trio.

Mr. Chung's teaching positions were at the Guang-Ren High School, Xi-Men Elementary School, and Guan-Du Christian College in Taiwan. He has been serving as the Music Director, cello and piano instructor at the Song of Songs Music School, Eastern School of Music, Amadeus Conservatory of Music, and Melody Time Music Center in the United States. In 2003, he was the Music Director and featured cellist for the world premiere of an original Chinese-language adaptation of A Streetcar Named Desire at the Hwa-Sun Culture Center in Taipei, Taiwan.







What are some hobbies that you enjoy doing?

Some of my hobbies include fencing, tennis, painting, and rock climbing. Fencing has been part of me since high school. I also fence outside school to improve my skills, enjoy footwork, and wear heavy, sweaty suits. I play tennis mainly in the summer because the courts are not indoors. I am also on my school's tennis team to continue tennis as a hobby. Painting is another hobby that makes me feel relaxed and free from worries. The satisfaction I receive when I brush the paint on my canvas to create artwork is worth the three hours. One of my favorite sports that was once my least favorite sport is rock climbing. When I first went rock climbing at the Cliffs LIC for a birthday party, I was not too fond of it because of the height and the fact that I was not skillful at it. However, a few years later, when my friends introduced me again to rock climbing, I fell in love with the idea of using all my body muscles to use the grips to go on top of the wall. The height no longer scared me; I found it part of why I love climbing.

What is your favorite genre of music and why?

My favorite genre of music is pop music, but I prefer to play classical music. I listen to pop music when I am in all sorts of emotions, whether on the train after failing a test or at an event with my friends. However, I like to play classical music because it makes me feel special to play music from the past by famous composers.

Is there something you've always wanted to do, but never had the courage to do so? If so, what is it?

I feared failure and judgment from people of higher knowledge and education. Therefore, I kept my story to myself with dreams of speaking to the public about an event that people can relate to. If you only had two words to describe yourself, what would it be and why?

"Challenge fear" is a phrase with two words I will use to describe myself. I used to ignore my fears and give up what made me uneasy because I believed that ignoring the problem would make me forget about it. However, I kept remembering the past, and the difficulties reoccurred unexpectedly, and I did not know how to face them. Whether the problem was a person who made my hobby into a trauma or a topic I didn't want to return to, it was like a boomerang. It was unavoidable. I didn't want to make myself uncomfortable when encountering such challenges. Therefore, instead of fearing my past, I challenged myself to make that fear an accomplishment or a friend.






